



Western Riding Instruction Information & Pricing

Trotting Tots – Ages: 4-6 **

This package is for riders who aren't big enough to ride on their own in lessons but want to spend time in the saddle. These are designed for ages 4-7, and will teach the young rider about proper balance on a horse as well as steering. These lessons are taught while the lesson helper guides the horse on a lead line.

Beginning Western – Ages: 7 & up **

The first lessons will start with the basics of horsemanship, from the ground up. This includes how to handle a horse, grooming and tacking for riding. Then we focus on building the horse and rider connection starting with mounting the horse and having the proper seat while on the horse. We start with the walk and the basic commands with steering, stopping, speeding up and slowing down. We keep balance and position in check as we increase the speed and go from walk to trot to loping. We build confidence by taking it one step at a time and teach how to properly control and read your horse using your hands, legs and seat.

Intermediate 2 Advanced

These lessons include all the skills from the beginning western lessons and are designed for riders that are comfortable with the basic horse care but want to fine tune their riding skills, or learn new techniques. These students will learn how to develop the balance and confidence to ride all of the horse's gaits. Instructors will help provide the rider with a safe and fun horseback riding experience while introducing new techniques and skills.

Boarders & Leasers:

\$35 per 60 minute private lesson

Helmets will be provided for the first month of riding. Proper attire for riding is long pants and boots with a slight heel. If you have any questions about student attire, please do not hesitate to ask your instructor! We are here to help you with all your horse and rider needs!

Students have TWO weeks after the date of their final lesson in the package to make up any missed lessons or they will be forfeited.

*** We ask that parents participate in the ground portion of the lesson until their child is able to perform these tasks on their own.*
